I cannot believe as I look out of my office today the change in the weather. I know it is cold but so much better than all the rain we have had lately.

## My child at school (MCAS)

A reminder that we are transitioning from ParentMail to the **My Child at School** App. The app is part of Bromcom, the software recently introduced across West Sussex schools, for managing all pupil, staff and finance data. **The whole school will be moved over to MCAS by the end of January and ParentMail will be discontinued**, a saving of over £2000 per year for the school.

You will be sent an invitation to set up your account. If you are already set up due to having a sibling in a year group who have already gone through this process please disregard any other invitations. If a sibling is not showing on your account just in get in touch.

I have attached a parent guide which is very lengthy so here are a few useful pointers I have picked up so far:

- Passwords must have 8 or more characters, 1 uppercase character, 1 numeric character and 1 special character.
- If your screen shakes when you're entering the new password you're not meeting the criteria above.
- When you have set up you login details in the browser, go to the app <a href="https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.bromcom.mcas&hl=en\_GB&gl=US">https://play.google.com/store/apps/details?id=com.bromcom.mcas&hl=en\_GB&gl=US</a> (android) or <a href="https://apps.apple.com/gb/app/mychildatschool/id1394575255">https://apps.apple.com/gb/app/mychildatschool/id1394575255</a> (ios).
- To log in to the app, click 'login with username & password' then enter the following:
  - o The school number is 13241
  - o The username from your invitation email NOT your email address
  - o The new password you set up when you registered

Please note, we will only be using certain elements of the system to begin with. Some features are designed for secondary schools and others may be introduced over time. Initially we will be using the app for **communication and bookings/payments.** 

Once you've logged in, if you have more than one child you will be able to change between them in the menu in the top left hand corner.

I'd really appreciate it if you can register your account ASAP as so that we do not spend valuable time reminding and chasing registrations.

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#### **Clubs this term**


Miss McGuinness will be running two clubs this term, starting next week and running for 10 weeks
