
We Three Kings





The Big Picture



In this learning experience you are going to learn about kingdoms. What is a kingdom and who rules over them? What does it mean to be a follower? How should kings and rulers speak to their people? How should they govern? You will be learning about the King of England, the ruler of the country, Rishi Sunak and the King of the Jews, Jesus Christ and comparing them all. You will also be writing your own public address. Will it be like Jesus' stories or like a Prime Minister's public speech? As a backdrop to your public address you will write your own piece of music!

Steps to Success

Hook: If I were King or Queen for the day, what would I do?

Step I: Who are our three kings? We will be writing factfiles about all three and finding suitable adjectives to describe them. How do they differ?

Step 2: What is a Kingdom? How do the kingdoms of our three kings compare?

Step 3: How do our three kings differ in how they speak to their people?


Step 4: Diving into addressing the public. How would we choose to do so? What do we need to include in our address? Looking at the features of a persuasive speech, including fronted adverbials.

Step 5: Reflecting and evaluating what Christians mean when they talk about the Kingdom of God.

Step 6: Delivering our public address—If I were King or Queen for the day...

Step 7: Compose and perform soundtrack for our public speech.
