Bosham Primary School Exclusion Policy

The following statement can be found in our Behaviour Management Policy

Exclusions

It is the school's hope that exclusion will be a very rare final sanction, when all other routes towards improved behaviour have failed. However, in extreme circumstances the exclusion process might need to be invoked. The governing body has decided that in exceptional circumstances that exclusion will be used as a sanction either as a:

- fixed term, or;
- permanent exclusion.

An exclusion would normally only be required if a child had:

- o committed an offence outside the law
- o put others (pupils or staff) at risk, including physical assault
- o seriously affected the education of others
- o made unfounded, malicious allegations against staff

The exclusion procedures will be initiated by the Acting Head teacher. The guidance set out in DfE's guidance 'Exclusion' will be followed (Appendix i), and that document therefore constitutes a part of the school's Behaviour Policy. The Acting Head teacher will record this on CPOMS as well as with the LA.
