
#### **Change of School Hours**

As you may be aware that the Government has published a mandatory change for schools to ensure they deliver 32.5 hours of education to pupils as a minimum expectation. This has to be undertaken by September 2023 so next term we will be moving our school times to come in line with this. Following our parent consultation that finished on the 9<sup>th</sup> February, it was clear the earlier start was the most preferred option.
