Shoebox Scheme

The Rotary club of Chichester Priory is once again participating in the Wessex Shoebox Programme, and we are going to participate as a school. This year we are planning to send Shoeboxes to underprivileged children in time for Christmas and we will be focusing on countries such as Ukraine, Moldova, Montenegro, Poland and Romania. The distribution of Shoeboxes to deserving children is managed by Rotarians in the recipient countries.



<p>AGE 1 - 3 YEARS (Boy or girl)</p> <p><i>CHOOSE FROM</i></p> <p>Small soft toy, picture book, hat, gloves, socks, soap, hairbrush, flannel, toothbrush and toothpaste, plus any other suitable small items.</p>
<p>AGE 4 - 7 YEARS (Boy or girl)</p> <p><i>CHOOSE FROM</i></p> <p>Pictorial educational book and game, simple jigsaw, ball, lego, crayons and colouring book, hat, gloves, scarf, socks, soap, hairbrush, flannel, toothbrush and toothpaste, toy vehicle, small doll, skipping rope.</p>
<p>AGE 8 - 11 YEARS (Boy or girl)</p> <p><i>CHOOSE FROM</i></p> <p>Pictorial educational book and game, jigsaw, ball, card game, felt tip pens, pencils, pencil case, drawing book, hat, gloves, scarf, socks, wide toothed comb, soap, flannel, toothbrush and toothpaste, sports item, skipping rope, hair accessories.</p>
<p>AGE 12 - 15 YEARS (Boy or girl)</p> <p><i>CHOOSE FROM</i></p> <p>Pictorial educational book and game, playing cards, geometry set, pens, pencils and case, pencil sharpener, rubber, writing/drawing book, hat, gloves, scarf, socks, wide toothed comb, soap, flannel, toothbrush and toothpaste, washbag, hair accessories, sports item.</p>

THINGS TO PUT IN YOUR SHOEBOX

- International Customs require items which must be for education, health and hygiene purposes
- All items must be new or in 'as new condition'

DO NOT INCLUDE

- Food of any kind
- Liquids of any kind
- Sweets of any kind
- Battery powered items
- War related items, toys, books, guns, knives etc
- Large items of clothing or shoes
- Books of a religious, racial or political nature
- Medicines
- Large toys
- Sharp items

They will supply preprinted Shoeboxes and clear instructions as to what may be included in the Shoebox. There is a copy of our instructions on what you can put in your Shoebox below. The preprinted Shoeboxes will be available by the end of September. In order to get the Shoeboxes to the children in time for Christmas, they will be collecting filled boxes from our school no later than 25th October – just before half term. 


