## Parking around the School


Since we have been back at school there have been a lot of complaints from local residents and village hall users about the car parking around school.

### Please support the school by not doing any of the following:

- Parking on the zig zag lines or in the bus stop on Walton Lane as this is often needed for minibuses and / or taxis for pupils who are coming to school.
- Using the school car park as the home owners at the end of School Lane are unable to access their homes when cars are not parked in the bays.
- Using the village hall car park as users of the hall often require their cars to transport themselves around as their mobility can be more limited. Also parents of young children need to use the hall to drop their children at the Nursery.

- Park and Stride at the Catholic Church car park or along Walton Lane after the Berkeley Arms.
- Walk or cycle as it is a great way to start and finish the school day for the children.
