

Flu Vaccinations

Many parents have queried why the flu vaccinations are in December this year. We have received the following response from the flu vaccination team.

"We plan the 667 schools in Sussex on a rotational basis over a 13-week period, starting in September and completing the final school sessions in December. To ensure fairness, we try to alternate schools between earlier and later dates each year. Unfortunately, due to geography and the need to group schools efficiently, this isn't always possible.

In 2024/25, your school originally had a December date, but you requested an earlier slot, and we were able to visit in October instead. The peak of flu season typically continues through December and January, so all children will still be vaccinated in time. Unfortunately, all available days are now booked up until 17th December this year"

Impetigo

We wanted to make you aware that there have been a few cases of impetigo reported in school. Please be vigilant for the following symptoms in your child: red sores or blisters, often around the mouth, nose, or hands, which may ooze or form a crust. If you notice any of these signs, we kindly ask that you contact your GP for advice and treatment before sending your child back to school. Thank you for helping us keep all our children safe and healthy.

Catamarans and Sunbeams (Year 6 and Year 5): J.K Rowling



Her books are mostly adventure and fantasy, with daring twists and happy endings.
